

Compensation is provided commensurate to the Fellow's past experience.

Responsibilities:

- » Engagement planning/coordination/execution
- » Site documentation
- » Activation coordination and implementation
- » Engagement and activation event marketing, storytelling and collateral design
- » Case studies and precedent studies
- » Program research and documentation
- » Illustrative planning, modeling and rendering
- » Policy research
- » Documentation, presentations and reports

Office Administration:

- » Printing and shipping coordination
- » Assist in the maintenance and organization of online and offline resources (digital resources like reports and photos, YARD and Playbook Resource Libraries, activation equipment, office supplies, etc.)

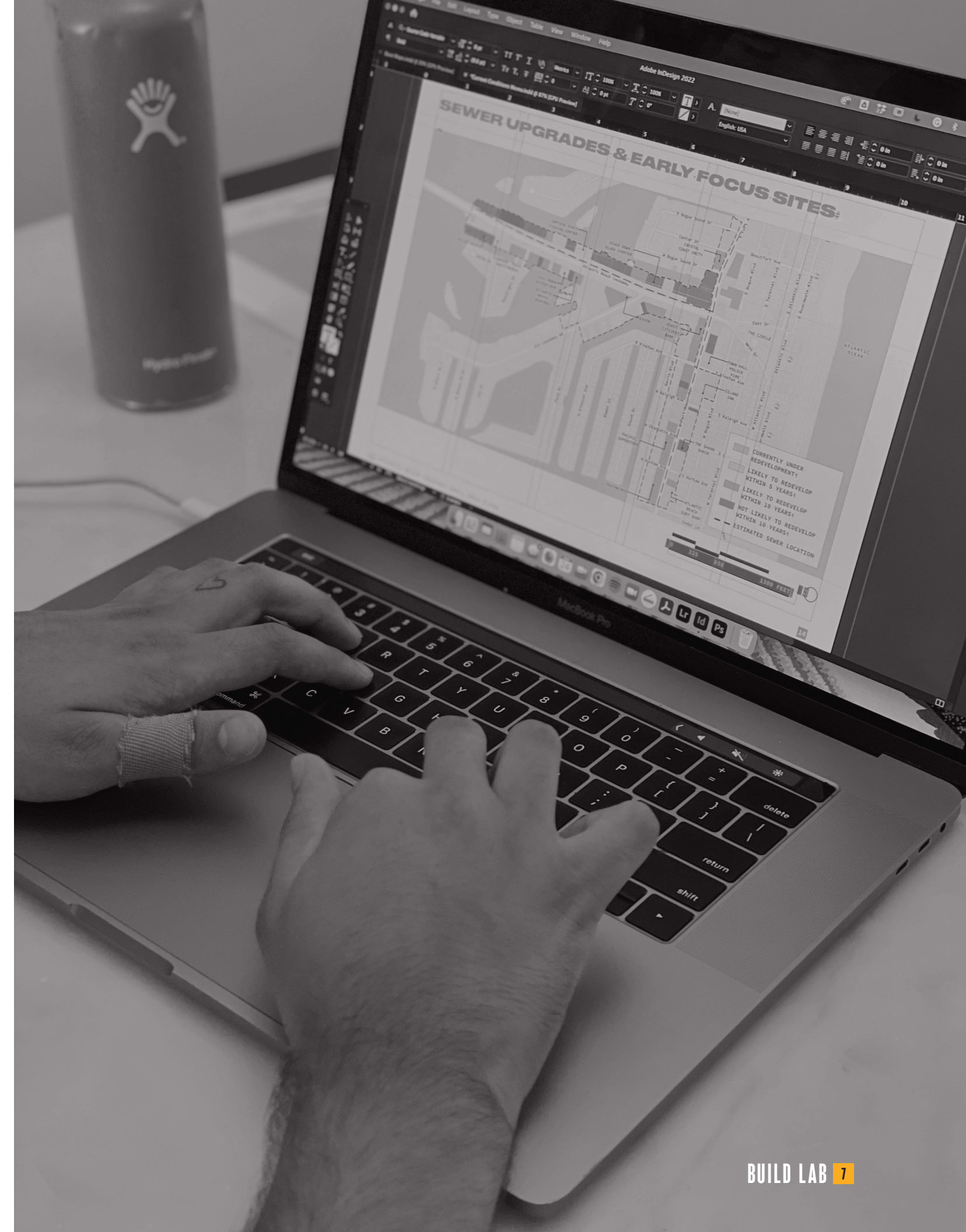


REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS & SKILLS

This position requires creative energy, efficiency and proficiency in some, but not all of the following areas:

- » Teamwork and collaboration
 - » Internal and outward communication (verbal, writing, visual, etc)
 - » Hand drawing, photography and visual/graphic design
 - » Use of common tools to build activation/programming components
 - » Ability to carry moderate loads
